There has been a “record number of attacks” against small businesses, and each small business has a 36.12 percent chance of experiencing a cyberattack in any given year.

- “Forty-two (42) percent of small businesses attacked lost revenue due to the cyber event.” An attack can cost your business up to \$200,000, in addition to higher dollar-value events.
- In addition to financial losses, “more businesses saw other increased impacts, such as more customers losing trust (32 percent), higher regrettable employee turnover (32 percent) and increased difficulty understanding what happened.”
- “Above everything else, cybercriminals are opportunistic, and they often see small and medium-sized businesses as prime targets due to a perception that they will have weaker cybersecurity defenses.”
- Cybersecurity insurance does not prevent a cyberattack in the first place and will *not* cover all the often-substantial losses from a cyberattack.
